

## SACRY SCHOLARSHIP

The Sacry Scholarship Fund has been established to honor Carroll and Cora Sacry in recognition of the influence they and their descendents have had for more than sixty years at Whitehall High School toward promoting academic excellence and high quality athletic development. The Sacry Family makes this award annually to students who have proved themselves to be fine scholars, talented athletes, good leaders, and who exhibit good moral character.

Two awards of \$1000.00 will be given to two graduating seniors to be applied toward college tuition and fees. Considerations upon which the scholarship will be granted are:

1. The applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average during the first seven semesters of high school.
2. The applicant must have participated for two years in at least two sports (track, cross country, football, basketball, wrestling, or volleyball). The applicant must have received three letters in varsity sports or two letters in varsity sports and one in band.
3. Attention will be given to the number and types of school activities in which the applicant has been involved.
4. The applicant must have displayed good citizenship and leadership during high school, and must exhibit good moral character.
5. The recipient must show proof of college registration to:

6. Applicants may be called for a person interview by the selection committee.
7. The application for the Sacry Scholarship must be returned to the Whitehall High School Guidance Counselor by May 1.
8. The selection committee may be composed of five persons:  
One administrator- appointed by the superintendent of schools,  
One faculty member-appointed by the superintendent of schools  
The high school athletic director  
Sacry Family may appoint two members
9. Decisions of the selection committee are final.

### Checklist:

\_\_\_\_\_ Make a list of all the sports you have participated in and include the years in which you played them. Be sure to note varsity recognition if it applies during certain years.

\_\_\_\_\_ Make a list of all your extracurricular activities and include all volunteer work. Write the school years you were engaged in the activities.

\_\_\_\_\_ Write a letter of intent explaining your educational goals, schools of choice, what degree you are seeking and desired profession.
