➤ Award Selection:

We encourage submissions from both boys and girls. Our desire is to grant an award to a boy and to a girl. If the application pool does not support this, the award(s) will be given to the top applicants. The Board has discretion on how to grant the award and reserves the right not to award.

Scholarship Requirements:

Student must have:

1. Grade Point Average of 2.75 or better.
2. Participation in at least three (3) extracurricular activities.
3. 2 letters of recommendation from adults with knowledge of the student. One must be from a school sponsored/affiliated activity.
4. Attend a private, public or vocational school with a program of at least nine months. Must be a full time student, however that is defined at that particular school.
5. Consideration may be given to a Booster Club Member's son or daughter, all other criteria being equal.

Process:

1. Applications will be accepted beginning March 1st and will close the 1st Friday of April. Applications are in the school counselor's office.
2. Completed application needs to be-mailed to PO Box 179, Whitehall, Montana 59759
3. Scholarship awards will be announced shortly after the May Booster Club meeting.
4. The scholarship check will be made out to the school of the applications choice or to the recipient of the scholarship after the recipient submits a copy of their first semester grades to the Booster Club.
5. The award check will be given the second quarter or second semester following high school graduation. The recipient must attend school and maintain full-time status and a 2.75 GPA on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent if on a different grading system.
